HOLY THURSDAY, APRIL 13th—We begin the three days (Triduum) which are the center of the Church Year. On this day Jesus instituted the Sacraments of the Holy Eucharist and Priesthood at the Last Supper, which was the FIRST MASS. The evening Mass will be 7:00 pm with the ceremonial washing of the feet of 12 men representing the 12 Apostles and the procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the Repository. Adoration at the Repository will continue. There is no morning Mass. Confessions will be heard from 6:00 pm to 6:45 pm.

GOOD FRIDAY, APRIL 14th—On this day we commemorate the death of Jesus on the Cross. Our Good Friday Communion Service will be 7:00 pm. At 3:00 pm we will have the Stations of the Cross. Today's collection is for the Holy Land Shrine. Good Friday is a day of fast and abstinence. Confessions from 6:00 pm to 6:45 pm. There is a Spanish Service at 4:00 pm.

HOLY SATURDAY, APRIL 15th—Solemn Easter Vigil Service begins at 7:00 pm, this is the only Mass today. This service consists of the Service of Light, the Liturgy of the Word, the Blessing of the new water with the renewal of our baptismal promises and the Easter Solemn Mass. Confessions from 4:00 pm to 5:00 pm.
