

## **SAINT BARTHOLOMEW CHURCH**

### **FEAST OF ST. CHARLES BORROMEIO—**

Each year the Missionaries of St. Charles (more commonly known as Scalabrinians) celebrate the feast of their patron, St. Charles Borromeo, on November 4. Our parish of St. Bartholomew has been staffed by the Scalabrinians since its founding in 1907. St. Charles, who died in 1584, was the Cardinal-Archbishop of Milan, Italy, a staunch reformer of the Church, and an Extraordinary Pastor of souls. It was he who began our modern seminary system for training of priests. During a severe outbreak of the plague, he assisted his people personally and died shortly after at the age of 48. Blessed John Baptist Scalabrini, founder of the Religious Congregation of Priests, Brothers and Sisters chose St Charles as heavenly patron and model for his spiritual sons and daughters because of his great pastoral zeal and care for those who migrated from the Diocese of Milan to Switzerland. ### **ALL SAINTS DAY**

#### **A HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 1<sup>st</sup>**

This annual celebration in the Church reminds us that we are called to be saints. On this special day we honor the many canonized saints, and also those who have gone before us and are now in heaven. This Feast demonstrates the great respect we render to all holy men and holy women of the past. Honoring the saints reminds us of our own goal of attaining Heaven as a reward for our efforts in living out the Gospel of Jesus in our everyday lives.

**ALL SOULS DAY, NOVEMBER 2<sup>nd</sup>**—On All Souls Day we pray for our deceased loved ones, for those who one day will be saints but may presently be in purgatory until they are purified of all sin. The Bible reminds us: “It is a good and holy thought to pray for the dead, that they may be freed from their sins.” St. Ambrose further tells us: “We have loved them during life, let us not abandon them until we have conducted them by our prayers into the House of the Lord.”
