Name your favorite Apostle.

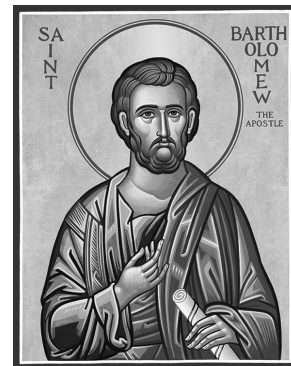

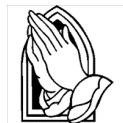
