Name your favorite Apostle.

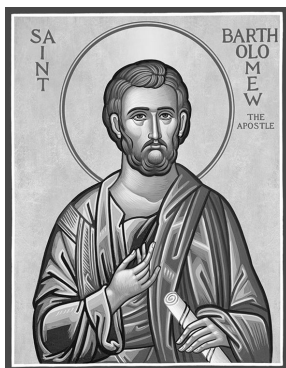
You might relate to the enthusiastic and often impetuous St. Peter. Maybe John's love touches your heart. In times of doubt, you might find hope in Thomas.
