OUR PATRON ST. BARTHOLOMEW

He was chosen by our Lord Himself to be one of the 12 Apostles (also know in the Gospel as Nathanael). He preached the Gospel in Asia Minor. The last field of his labors was Armenia. Tradition records that he was first flayed and then, in imitation of Christ, crucified. His relics are preserved in the church dedicated to him on the Isola Tibertina, in Rome's Tiber River. We are honored to call him our PARISH PATRON!
