Please accept the invitation to share the coming HOLY WEEK with us, your parish family, as we relive the sacred mysteries and holy events of our salvation accomplished by Jesus during His final days on earth. Make the week different from other weeks of the year. Join with us as we recall our Christian roots by proclaiming the MYSTERIES OF OUR FAITH: CHRIST HAS DIED! CHRIST HAS RISEN! CHRIST WILL COME AGAIN! Make this truly be a HOLY WEEK for all!

HOLY THURSDAY, MARCH 29th - We begin the three days (Triduum) which are the center of our Church Year. On this day Jesus instituted the Sacraments of the Holy Eucharist and the Priesthood at the Last Supper, which was the FIRST MASS. The evening Mass will be 7:00 pm with the ceremonial washing of the feet of 12 men representing the 12 Apostles and the procession of the Blessed Sacrament to the Repository. Adoration at the Repository will continue until 10:00 pm. There is no morning Mass.

GOOD FRIDAY, MARCH 30th - On this day we commemorate the death of Jesus on the Cross. At 3:00 pm we will have the Stations of the Cross (English) in the Church. Good Friday Services are at 4:00 pm (Spanish) and 7:00 pm (English). Good Friday is a day of fast and abstinence.

HOLY SATURDAY, MARCH 31st - Solemn Easter Vigil Service at 7:00 pm, this is the only Mass today. This service consists of the Service of Light, the Liturgy of the Word, the Blessing of the new water with Baptism.
