THOUGHTS FOR THE FEAST OF THE BLESSED TRINITY – Today the Church celebrates the Feast of the Most Holy Trinity. Jesus Himself gave us a look into the very nature of God; that in one God there are three Divine Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. This belief of our Catholic Faith, is clearly found in the Scriptures; but the word "Trinity" (which means three in one) was coined by theologians during the early centuries to express this divine truth. This will always remain a mystery, for it is impossible to grasp the immensity of God. The best way for us to express our gratitude for this great mystery is to live fully our relationship with God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit! The Trinity is not so much a matter of discussion about God's nature; rather it is a matter of relationship with Him!
