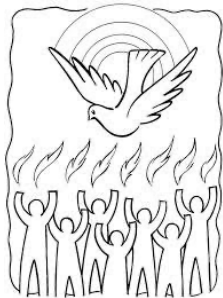


**FEAST OF PENTECOST
BIRTHDAY OF THE CHURCH**

The Candle reminds us that Christ is the light of the world and guide of our everyday lives, leading us all one day to our heavenly home.**
