Today's scriptures begin to focus on the end of time. Jesus tells us "**you know neither the day nor the hour**" (Matthew 25:13). However, we cannot wait around unprepared.

*So how do we prepare?*

In Jesus' parable, five wise virgins bring extra oil for their lamps so that they will remain radiant and unfading, while five foolish virgins, having neglected to bring more oil, carry lamps that flicker out. In their foolishness they ignored the special favor bestowed upon them to greet the bridegroom and guide him through the dark to the wedding feast. As Christians we have been given the greatest gift: *the life of God within us*. Are we foolish, excusing improper behavior or becoming lax? Let us use our wisdom and consider what we can do to brighten the path to God's Kingdom.

**Reflexión de las Escrituras**

¿Somos tontos, excusamos el comportamiento inadecuado o nos volvemos negligentes? Usemos nuestra sabiduría y consideremos qué podemos hacer para iluminar el camino hacia el Reino de Dios.
