



Gospel Scripture Reflection

The first lesson we can learn from today’s readings is cause for celebration: everyone is invited to God’s feast. What glorious news! But the second lesson is sobering: not everyone is allowed to stay. This parable recounts how God’s chosen people wouldn’t accept salvation offered by Christ, so others were given the offer. Now the invitation is ours. God’s invitation to the Kingdom is to be taken seriously and an ongoing response is expected. Simply showing up is not enough. God calls and clothes us with an unstained garment at our Baptism, symbolizing the new life to which we are called. Our lives are to be spent “putting on Christ.” *Have you accepted God’s invitation?*
