**FEAST OF ST. CHARLES BORROMEO**

Each year the Missionaries of St. Charles, the Scalabrinians, celebrate the feast of their patron, St. Charles Borromeo, on **November 4<sup>th</sup>**. Our parish has been staffed by the Scalabrinians since its founding in 1907. St. Charles, who died in 1584, was the Cardinal-Archbishop of Milan, Italy, a reformer of the Church, and an Extraordinary Pastor of souls. During a severe outbreak of the plague, he assisted his people personally and died shortly after at the age of 48. Blessed John Baptist Scalabrini chose St. Charles as heavenly patron and model for his spiritual sons and daughters because of his care for immigrants. NOVEMBER 1<sup>ST</sup>**

This Feast demonstrates the great respect we render to all holy men and holy women of the past. We are all children of God and will eventually see the face of God. In the Beatitudes, Jesus describes those who are blessed by God. In the end, they will be comforted by God, finding satisfaction in the Kingdom of Heaven. Honoring the saints reminds us of our own goal of attaining heaven as a reward for our efforts in living out the Gospel of Jesus.
