A Roman coin would have the emperor's image on it. Jesus makes His point when He receives a coin from questioners. Jesus advises them to payback the emperor what bears his image; but to return to God what bears the divine image themselves - heart, mind, and spirit. How successfully do we navigate paying to Caesar what belongs to Caesar; and to God what belongs to God?
